

SUPPLY LIST

Grade 2

Please use a permanent marker to LABEL the following items with your child's name:

- 1 sturdy plastic shoebox with lid with these items inside:
- 1 box 16 or 24 crayons
- 1 16-color set of watercolor paints
- 1 set of watercolor brushes in a variety of sizes
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 2 pairs of children's scissors
- 2 rulers (with inches and centimeters on each)-transparent, no designs
- 1 box 8 magic markers
- Do not send art kits

Other items that need to be LABELED with your child's name that will not be in the shoebox above:

- Lunch box or container with appropriate utensils
- Sturdy backpack or book bag-NO ROLLING BACKPACKS
- 1 clipboard
- 2 sturdy pocket folders with design on cover for privacy folders
- 1 blue heavy-duty plastic pocket folder, no brads
- 1 purple heavy-duty plastic pocket folder, no brads
- 2 one-subject wired spiral notebooks-(red, green)
- 1 red pocket folder with brads and notebook paper inserted
- Painting shirt, no aprons or smocks (Dad's t-shirt works best)

Other items that DO NOT need to be labeled with your child's name:

- 6 glue sticks
- 2 four-ounce bottles of liquid school glue
- 6 block erasers (pink)
- 32 Ticonderoga (yellow) No. 2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 2 sheets white poster board
- 2 packages of white copy paper (500 sheets)
- 4 rolls paper towels
- 1 bottle ANTIBACTERIAL soft soap (no large refill bottles)
- 1 box Family-size Facial Tissue
- 2 containers Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- 1 box of band-aids
- GIRLS: 1 box snack-size baggies & 1 box quart-size baggies
- BOYS: 1 package of modeling clay (no play-dough)

World Language Supplies

- 4 pocket folders with brads for World Languages (1@ red=label Chinese, blue=label French, yellow= label Spanish, and green= label German,) with lined writing paper in folder
