

## Supply List Grade 3

Attention: Front and Back of this Paper

**Please use a permanent marker to label the following items with your child's name.**

1 sturdy plastic shoebox with lid just large enough to hold these items:

- (1) box of 24 crayons, 1 box of 8 crayons
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- (24) no. 2 pencils sharpened
- (1) box of 8 washable markers
- (2) highlighters
- (1) clear ruler that has centimeters and sixteenths of an inch on it  
(can be found at Office Max)
- (3) large glue sticks
- (1) package of glitter glue with at least 4 different colors.
- (1) package of at least 4 dark colored dry erase markers
- (1) black fine point dry erase marker
- (1) Clipboard (with child's name)
- (1) box of gallon sized "freezer" bags
- (1) box of quart sized freezer bags with zippers
- (1) headphone set to be kept in the computer lab this year. Note: No ear buds

Note: Please choose small packages so these items will easily fit into a shoebox.

**Other items needed with your child's name on it.**

Lunch box or container with appropriate utensils

Sturdy book bag or backpack

- (2) cloth jumbo book covers for the math and reading books – (they are large books)
- (9) one subject (various colors are okay) notebooks (spelling, vocabulary, and writing)
- 6 various solid colored plastic pocket folders with fasteners or prongs
- 1 packages of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 5 black and white marbled covered composition notebooks (smaller version and wide-ruled)

**Art class supplies**

1 large poster board (This will become their art portfolio)  
1 16-color set of Crayola watercolor paints

Other items that do not need to be labeled with your child's name:  
5 rolls of paper towels  
2 boxes of tissues  
2 soft soap bottles  
2 large containers of Clorox/Lysol Wipes  
4 packages of copy paper (500 sheets)

### **World Language Supply List**

Spanish Class requires (1) – 1 inch 3-ring binder with lined writing paper and (4) pocket dividers. (Label the binder “World Languages”)  
1 - Language dictionary (from Barnes and Noble = Langenscheidt Spanish-English / EnglishSpanish for the Spanish students OR Langenscheidt German-English / English-German for the German students, PLEASE DO NOT SUBSTITUE)

### **Supply list for 3RD grade German**

1 large composition book - ruled Notebook  
(11 ¾ by 8 ¾ usually found at Office Depot or Office Max)  
(I am aiming to eliminate the loose paper “collection” and rather make this book a journal, reference and resource for the student now and in the years to come, for shopping reference see attached here)  
No spiral notebooks or loose paper and ring binders please!  
1 German – English dictionary  
(Langenscheidt is great, the pocket version is only good for a short time, it might be advisable to purchase the “big” edition that will last your student forever)
