The Village School remained the name used for the preschool through fifth grade, while the middle school adopted the name Oakbrook.

2002

Oakbrook Preparatory School was adopted for all students in grades one through 12 at the main campus, and Oakbrook Preschool was adopted for K-4 through K-5 at the Covenant campus.

2006

Oakbrook Preschool moved from Covenant to the main campus and once again all the students were together on one campus.

Be sure your phone numbers are correct in FACTS and that all parties are signed up to receive text alerts about important events and information related to the school.



Tuition payments must be made in accordance with the current Tuition & Fees schedule that families received with the Student Enrollment Contract. Tuition is due the 1st of each month beginning in July through June. Responsible parties should have received completed an online payment agreement through your existing FACTS/RenWeb Parent Portal when you completed the Enrollment Packet..

If you need to make special arrangements, have questions regarding your payment plan, or have billing inquiries please contact our Business Manager Amberly Deloach.

Here are some of the benefits you will see when using FACTS for your tuition payment plan:

- **Payment Schedule:** You may choose the 1st or 15th of each month as your payment date. A payment schedule will be generated for your records.
- **Payment Details:** You will enter the primary financial account for payments. Payments can be made from a checking or savings account or from a variety of credit cards. If you sign up for an automatic draft there is no set up fee. If you wish to make manual monthly payments there will be a one-time \$100 set up fee.
 - Bank Account options (automatic draft from checking/savings)* NO FEE.
 - Credit/Debit Card (automatic draft)* No set-up fee/2.85% surcharge fee.
 - Monthly Manual Payments annual \$100 set up fee plus 2.85% monthly surcharge if a credit/debit card is used.
 - If you have questions about cash, check, or 529 payments please contact Amberly Deloach..
- Convenience & Security: Along with multiple payment plan options, your payments are processed securely through a bank to bank transaction.
- **Consumer Account:** You may check your personal account or make payments online from the convenience of your home or office anytime. Payment methods include ACH, checks and debit/credit cards. Families can pay online, over the phone, by mail, or with auto-debit.
- Consumer Dashboard: You will have access to more information regarding your tuition and incidental charges.



What do we need?

Technology

K-5th graders will have access to school owned iPad's and Chromebooks that can be checked out by teachers.

5th-8th Grade will need a personal Chromebook with a minimum of 4GB of RAM and 10GB of free (internal) storage space.

9th grade-12th grade are strongly encouraged to bring a Chromebook or laptop daily. Recommended devices are Chromebooks, Microsoft Surface (3rd generation or above) or Macs. Kindles, Nooks, and phones are NOT recommended.

Laptops must also have an up-to-date antivirus program that is configured to routinely protect the system. (By their nature, Chromebooks are exempt from the antivirus requirements.)

Carpool Instructions

Grades K3-12

Arrival - Carpool & Early Bird

- ALL students in K3-grade 2 will be dropped off at the Primary Building. If dropped off between 7:45 and 8:00, students will wait in Early Bird until time to go to class. There will be a staggered dismissal from Early Bird beginning at 7:45 with 3rd grade and ending at 8:00 with K3. NO students should be dropped off before 7:30.
- ALL students in grades 3-8 will be dropped off at the Gym Building. NO students should be dropped off before 7:30 a.m. ALL students who arrive before 7:45 a.m. will go directly to Early Bird in the Gym. At 7:45, all students will report to their first class of the day.
- ALL students in grades 9-12 will be dropped off at the Main Building. NO students should be dropped off or arrive before 7:30 a.m. Student drivers will park in the Main Building lot (seniors only) and upper portion of the Primary lot. ALL students arriving between 7:30 a.m. and 7:45 a.m. will go directly to Early Bird in the gym until time for class. Student drivers should remain in their cars until 7:45 a.m. Upper School students will go directly to their first class of the day.
- Students in grades K3-2nd who arrive on campus after 8:15 a.m. as well as those in 3-12th who arrive tardy should report to the Main Office to sign in.

Oakbrook Snacks & Lunch

Parents and students (with login access) who wish to order lunch from one of our daily vendors/caterers should place their order before 8 a.m. each day.

K3-3rd grades eat lunch in their classrooms. 4th-12th will eat in the student commons or other designated areas. There are vending machines on campus for middle and upper school students. These items may be purchased and kept in the lunch areas.

Students may bring lunch from home. ALL SCHOOL DAY SNACKS MUST BE PROVIDED BY PARENTS. Students who stay for Knight Shift will be provided a snack as part of the cost.





HOW TO ORDER LUNCH (via Oakbrook Family app):

- Open the app
- Click on "Lunch"
- Click on Create Web Order button
- Click "Collapsible"
- A Lunch Order Menu will appear for each individual student in the family (i.e.: Lunch Ordering for John)
- Select Menu Choices for each student listed (labeled at the top of the menu) by clicking in QTY

 Box (Do Not press your Enter button) and recording the number of menu items for each day
- Scroll down for next student listed (labeled at the top of the menu) and select menu items
- Once all orders have been selected scroll down to bottom of page for Grand Total and click on Order Items button
- Lunch charges will appear on your monthly invoice
